

Dear Scouts:

I thought you might be interested in learning where the Army has been in its efforts to develop an Advanced Scout

Helicopter (ASH).

Since the TRADOC System Manager (TSM) office for the ASH was established in July 1977, numerous questions have been received asking for information as to what, where, and when the ARmy will obtain a scout helicopter.

Needed was an ASH capable of performing the missions and tasks of a scout within air cavalry (where he is the eyes and ears of the commander); in the attack helicopter company (as Team Leader/scout in partnership with the attack helicopters to find, fix, and destroy the enemy armor threat); and in Division Artillery (as aerial forward

observers).

Surprisingly enough, Army studies recognizing the need for an ASH date back to early 1970. A review of combat within a mid-to high-intensity battlefield environment resulted in the realization that the then current Light Observation Helicopter (LOH) fleet would need updating. This realization culminated in January 1974 with the approval of an ASH Required Operational Capability (ROC) document by Department of the Army.

An interesting chain of significant events have ensued since 30 January 1974, and I would like to share them with you!

MARCH 1974. The Commander USA Armor Center, MG Don Starry, chaired a Special Task Force (STF) established to study the ASH ROC, validate the requirement, and prepare recommendations for submission to the Army Systems Acquisition Review Council (commonly referred to as ASARC).

FEBRUARY 1975. After a busy and energetic ten months of work, the Ft. Knox Special Task Force (STF) briefed the ASARC and convinced the council that the Army needed the ASH. Decisions from this

briefing led to:

 the initiation of an OH-58 Product Improvement Program (PIP), now known as the OH-58C interim scout (delivery to

begin in March 1978), and

(2) the next step in the acquisition process, submission to the DOD Acquisition Council, a step that would not be taken until four areas of operational uncertainty were resolved.

MARCH 1975. Hq TRADOC appointed a Scout Helicopter Special Study Group (SHSSG) at Ft. Monroe to study and resolved the operational uncertainties

identified by the ASARC an to prepare the ASH concept for the DOD review.

JUNE 1975. The ASARC principals were briefed by the SHSSG. The SHSSG recommended:

 the Army seek DOD approval for the advanced development of an ASH capable of being armed, and

(2) the ASH be a new development that would possess a day/night target acquisition and precision designation capability and be compatible with the Advanced Attack Helicopter (AAH).

SEPTEMBER 1975. The Army ASH requirement was presented to the DOD Defense Systems Acquisition Review Council (DSARC) and received approval for the need and authorization for development program initiation. The Council stipulated, however, that another review would be conducted within 60 days.

MARCH 1976. The follow-on DSARC-1A was convened to review the ASH program. This review resulted in tentative program approval. Next step - ON TO CON-GRESS!

SEPTEMBER 1976. The ASH arrived in Congress only to see the Joint Appropriations Committee delete the \$2 million from the FY 77 funds needed for a program start. The Army's attempts to use uncommitted FY 76 and 7T funds were also unsuccessful. The end results were a two-year program delay for the ASH and the closing of the DARCOM ASH Project Manager Office (October 1976).

Located at Ft. Rucker, AL, the TSM—ASH Office calls for four officers (with titles above), a GS-13 Aeronautical Engineer, and a Clerk-Steno. TSM—ASH is located in Building 503 with phones at (205) 255-3808/4909/2872.

JULY 1977. The TRADOC System Managers Office for the ASH (TSM-ASH) office was established at Ft. Rucker. This office was chartered with the responsibility to represent the user in all scout helicopter matters. The initial effort was the submission of coordinated TRADOC-updated ASH ROC to DA designed to realign the ASH requirements with current times.

NOVEMBER 1977. The ASH program was taken abroad and introduced to the NATO Alliance during a Panel X meeting. This initiative was in support of current DOD policy to include NATO Standardization and Interoperability (S&I) considerations in major equipment development programs.

DECEMBER 1977. A TRADOC briefing ("Why the ASH?") was presented to Dr. Walter B. LaBerge, Under Secretary of the Army, addressing the Army's requirement for an ASH. The taskings resulting from this briefing are currently being acted on.

JANUARY — MARCH 1978. The ASH became a major player in the studies of the Army Aviation Rationalization, Standardization, and Interoperability (RSI) Committee convened in ST. Louis. The ASH requirements were to be refined and compared to the NATO Attack Helicopter

(NAH) requirement while considering U.S./European new developments and derivatives of current and developmental systems. The actions and final report of the RSI Committee are still pending.

FEBRUARY 1978. An ASH Survivability Symposium was held at Ft. Rucker; the first, incidently, to be ever hosted at Ft. Rucker by the AAAA's local Chapter. The symposium was designed to provide a medium for the exchange of information and ideas among the developer, manufacturer, and user.

As one can quickly gather there has been a great deal of interplay within the ASH program. What has been outlined here are just a few of the major historical highlights.

There is a strong and steady effort taking place to get an ASH to the field. Hopefully, someday soon, one will hear the order "SCOUTS OUT" and see the ASH take its place out front.

The Quest for Flight - Part II From balloons to gliders


For centuries cave dwellers, priests, scholars, Indians and enthusiasts, sitting round a fire, had watched the smoke ascend, little guessing that this simple phenomenon was the clue to solving the initial problem of flight.

Joseph and Etienne Montgolfier, sons of a paper-maker in Annonay near Lyon, had always dreamed about being able to fly. One evening in November 1782 the brothers were speculating on why the smoke from their fire went up and not down. They fetched the lightest paper bag they could find in their shop and put it over a small fire lit for the purpose. It filled with hot air and started to rise, only to fall again. Obviously more smoke was needed so Joseph put some damp straw on the fire; again the paper bag made a valiant effort to rise but this time did not get so high.

A mysterious "gas"

Thinking that smoke was a 'gas' with a mysterious lifting capacity, the brothers did not realize that it ascends because it contains expanded warm air which is lighter than the surrounding air. They continued, however, with

their experiments filling their factory with vast clouds of noxious smoke to the undisguised distress of their fellow workers.

During the winter **Joseph** and **Etienne** constructed a paper bag with a capacity of 600 cubic feet. When they tried to test it, it broke loose from its moorings and soared to 600 feet or so before descending to envelope a somewhat surprised cow. After further experiments the brothers decided that the time had come for a public demonstration.

Ridicule . . and success!

On 4 June 1783 an immense fire, flanked by piles of chopped straw and wool, was lit in the main square of Annonay. The local peasants and skeptics, sure of failure consequently expressed a bit of ridicule at the expense of these two lunatics and, gathered round. Eventually into the square was brought the 'Globe Aerostatique' later to be dubbed a Montgolfier (the word, "balloon," had not been coined), a linen bag lined with paper, 30 feet in diameter and with a capacity of 23,000 cubic feet. A grate of burning charcoal was suspended under the open neck to provide heat once he balloon had left the ground.

The crowd, yelling cat-calls, soon quietened as the balloon started to ascend. The awe-struck peasants, momentarily dumbfounded, gave a rousing cheer. The Globe Aerostatique climbed to about 6,000 feet and travelled some two miles before landing.

The Montgolfiers were invited to give an explanation of this wonder before the Academy of Sciences in Paris. Before Etienne could make the long journey a Professor Charles decided that he should join these aeronautical activities. Unaware of the peculiar lifting properties of smoke, he decided to fill his balloon of varnished silk, only 15 feet in diameter, with the newly isolated gas hydrogen.

Known as a Charliere, this balloon was released from the Champ des Mars on 27 August 1783. It climbed rapidly through a heavy shower and disappeared into a cloud. Charles and his helpers, the Robert brothers, leaped aboard three horses and gave chase.


The "first UFO"

In the meantime, about 15 miles away, the balloon landed by some terrified farm workers. Thoroughly alarmed by this forbidding UFO which had descended without warning through the clouds to devour their crops, they courageously attacked it with scythes and pitchforks, tearing it to pieces. The breathless Charles, when he arrived at the scene, was something less than ecstatic to see the forlorn shreds of silk.

On 19 September 1783 Louis XVI, Queen Marie Antoinette, Benjamin Franklin, and a few other visionaries assembled at the Court in Versailles to watch as the crew of three went aboard a new Montgolfiere. The balloon rose majestically and flew for two miles before landing safely. The crew were uncommunicative about their ordeal although to experienced observers it was clear that the cock and the sheep had had a difference of opinion to the acute discomfiture of the cock. The third crew member, a duck, treated the whole affair with becoming nonchalance.

In decorating the brothers and sparing the crew from ending up on his plate, the King intimated that he would welcome something a little more daring. In a magnificently philanthropic gesture he offered two condemned criminals as the first human crew. This was quite inappropriate, thought Jean-Francois Pilatre de Rozier, the King's historian and a man keen to secure his own place in history: criminals were not worthy of such an honour. He would go alone. On 15 October 1783 he rose in a captive balloon to about 80 feet and remained there for about 4½ minutes.

On 21 November de Rozier and the equally fearless Marquis d'Arlandes made the first human aerial voyage in history. Large doses of hot air and cold sweat enabled the aeronauts to

reach 3,000 feet and travel across Paris while remaining airborne for 23 minutes. A little minor difficulty arose when the balloon predictably caught fire but the crew were equal to the emergency.


Just ten days later, on 1 Decenber 1783, Charles took off with one of the Robert brothers in a hydrogen-filled Charliere from the Tuileries Gardens in front of a crowd of 400,000 spectators. Having been airborne for two hours and having travelled 27 miles, Charles descended to shed some excess ballast in the shape of Robert. The balloon immediately shot up to 9,000 feet so terrifying Charles that he never flew again.

Hydrogen was clearly better than hot air: while de Rozier and d'Arlandes had been feverishly stoking, Charles had been able to sit back and panic. The explosive nature of the gas was only learned later at the cost of a number of lives. Not until the German airship Hindenburg was lost at Lakehurst, N.J., in 1937 was hydrogen abandoned as a lifting gas.

The women join in!

With ballooning now offering women a much more comfortable ride than broomsticks, both sexes took to the air in ever-increasing numbers. It was Jean Pierre Blanchard who entered the Guinness Book of Records by making the first nude balloon flight. On 7 January 1785 he and his financial backer made the first crossing of the English Channel. Dr. Jeffries was called upon to make a rather greater donation than he had anticiapated as the balloon sank towards the icy sea. Every bit of obvious

ballast had been jettisoned; now there was nothing left but their clothes. (Hot air balloons

had their advantages after all!)

Fortunately this had the desired effect and the balloon was able to maintain height and complete the crossing. This adventure had a chilling effect on Jeffries but Blanchard went to Philadelphia where he made the first balloon flight in America on 9 January 1793 in the presence of George Washington.

This year also saw the formation of the first military balloon corps in France. Balloons were later used to carry passengers and mail out of Paris during the German siege of 1870.

Silk dresses and petticoats

Both sides in the American Civil War used observation balloons. It was only the generosity of certain ladies that made this possible for the Confederate Army: overcoming their scruples these Southern Belles gave freely of their silk dresses and petticoats and "soon we had a great patchwork ship of many and varied hues."

A Yankee balloon first detected General Lee's movement westward to start the Gettysburg campaign. At one time a 'hot line' linked a balloon with the White House. The first of the stunt ballooners was probably Washington Donaldson, a ventriloquist, conjurer, acrobat, etc., but clearly a navigator of dubious skill. Setting out to cross the Atlantic form New York City in 1873 he was surprised to find himself landing in the Catskills.

The last great balloon adventure of the 19th



century was the Swedish explorer Andree's attempt to overfly the North Pole with two companions in July 1897. Five floating buoys and a carrier pigeon were the only links with the expedition until three frozen bodies and a log were discovered not far from the Pole in 1930.

The trouble with balloons was that they had minds of their own. To be able to coerce them in a chosen direction some sort of propulsion was needed. Sails, oars, paddles and hand-cranked propellers were all used but still the balloons obstinately refused to deviate from their chosen course. Perhaps one of those new-fangled engines would do the trick.

Henri Giffard, a French engineer, built a cigar-shaped balloon, 144 feet long, powered by a 350 lb. 3 HP steam engine. This airship gallantly took off on 24 September 1852 and made its way from Paris to Trappers at a sedate 5 mph. This was man's first powered aircraft, a dirigible, or steerable, airship; it could not, however, fly into wind.

The first practical airship

On 9 August 1884 the first practical airship, La France, powered by an 8.5 HP electric motor, flew at an incredible 14½ mph into wind. A year later the first practical petrol engines were built; the days of the floaters, flappers, and steamers as anything more than hobbies were numbered.

While dirigible drivers were trying to coax their lighter-than-air craft in the right direction, there were others, equally stubborn, who had the temerity actually to believe that heavierthan-air craft were the answer.

Sir George Cayley was one, conducting many experiments with models and full scale gliders. By 1809 he had gathered together all the aerodynamic theory necessary for the design of a man-carrying aircraft. He roundly denounced ornithopters and made the revolutionary proposal of having a fixed wing for lift and a separate system for propulsion. The problem was "to make the surface support a given weight by the application of sufficient power to overcome the resistance of the air". He saw the need for moving vertical and horizontal surfaces (Otherwise known as rudder and elevator) to enhance stability and control.



1978 SPOOF ROSTER





Dear Fellow AAAA Member/Subscriber:

A certain number of our **military retired readers** queried us on the possibility of obtaining a list of the addresses of their fellow **retired readers**. Many had lost contact with their long-time friends; they indicated they'd like to establish communication with their old friends once again; and the "PCS — Change of Address" columns of the magazine were of little help for our **retired readers** were solid citizens now and no longer moved from spot to spot every few years. Hence, their addresses NEVER appeared in the magazine.

We felt that we could assist these subscribers by publishing a roster of our retired military readers, and then updating the roster each April issue. Any roster title that connoted gray heads, hesitant step, or gnarled hands would probably upset some of these readers — Who likes to be called a "Retread"? — so we chose the SPOOF acronym (Society for the Preservation of Old Friends). After all, the stated purpose of the roster is to keep old friends together, so "SPOOF ROSTER" it became.

For the record, there is NO CHARGE for this listing; the only cost the listee had to bear was the postage tab in returning his SPOOF Form. Also, we'd like you to know that the Privacy Act precluded our listing the names of those retired military members who did not return a form. Lastly, since we have no month-to-month contact with non-AAAA members, or have access to their addresses, the roster, out of necessity, only lists those readers who are AAAA members.

As a spin-off of this first SPOOF ROSTER, we plan to publish a late '78-early '79 "WHO'S WHO IN ARMY AVIATION" — a roster of AAAA's Aviation Warrant Officer members, the recognized "professionals" in this business. The "WHO'S WHO" would list the active Army and Reserve Component WO aviators, their assignments and aircraft qualifications, and their total first pilot, IP, and combat time. The response forms for the "WHO'S WHO" will be mailed to our AWO member-subscribers o/a 1 September. In still another 1979 centerfold, we'll publish "The DACk PACk" — the initial roster of the many DAC members of AAAA who support every phase of the overall Army Aviation operation.

A year after Giffard's first powered airship flight, Cayley had at last perfected a mancarrying glider. The year was 1853. Cayley, nearing 80, took his coachman to one side and explained that he was to be given a chance to become immortal. Against his better judgment, believing himself to be only too mortal, the coachman stepped gingerly aboard.

Within moments he found himself floating across a small valley in northern England. He landed, body intact but broken in spirit. "Sir George", he is reported to have said, "I wish to give notice. I was hired to drive, not fly". Cayley had been only partially right: his coachman had completed the first successful manned (but hardly piloted) gliding flight but nobody can remember his name!

The day of the "steamer"

Cayley was ahead of his time. The lack of a suitable engine restricted him to flying only models and gliders. Others were more ambitious but technically far less competent. A French naval officer built a monoplane in 1857 with a train-like boiler and smokestack. To nobody's surprise but his he only succeeded in


puffing noisily down a long ramp without leaving the ground.

Another steamer was the Frenchman, Clement Ader, who built a bat-like steam-driven monoplane. On 9 October 1890 he left the ground under power and was airborne for 160 feet. He jubilantly clalimed the first powered aeroplane flight but in truth it was no more than an excessive hop. His particular flight was neither sustained nor controlled. His claim was greeted with peals of incredulous laughter evenby his own countrymen.

Lack of space precludes a description of the last rush to true powered flight. The appearance of a practical engine utterly falled to convince Otto Lilienthal, a German civil engineer, who, between 1891 and 9 August 1896 when he killed himself, made over 2,000 gliding flights. His gliders had large bird-like wings and a fixed rear stabiliser.

Lilienthal was the first to demonstrate clearly that controlled heavier-than-air flight was possible for man. He achieved control by shifting his weight. He directly influenced the Wright brothers who, as all the world knows, made the very first powered, sustained and controlled flight in an aeroplane on 17 December 1903, But that is another story!
