ACAB: A STEPPING STONE TO MATCH FUTURE THREATS

NEW, yet evolutionary organizations, tactics, and weapons systems are being planned for the Army to meet numerically superior and increasingly sophisticated threats of the 1980's.

To determine how these new tactics and systems can be best utilized, the systems must be fielded and the tactics tested and evaluated in organizations designed to maximize their potential.

An organizational "First"

The "stepping stone" to this concept is the Army 86 study which is developing an organizational framework considering systems and tactics which are required to match the threat of the 1980's.

The Air Cavalry Attack Brigade (ACAB) is one of the new organizations resulting from the Army 86 effort. The ACAB will be the first Army 86 organization to be fielded and tested in the High Technology Test Bed (HTTB) which is now an integral part of the 9th Infantry Division.

The present 9th Combat Aviation Battalion and the 3d Squadron, 5th Cavalry (AIR) will have additional resources provided for the reconfiguration of these units into the ACAB organization.

The ACAB organizes all combat and combat support aviation elements under a fourth maneuver brigade headquarters in the division. This will provide the Division Commander with another maneuver headquarters and improved unity of command and support for all of aviation's battlefield missions.

Major subordinate organizations of the ACAB are the Combat Support Aviation Battalion (CSAB), the Cavalry Squadron, and two new Attack Helicopter Battalions.

The fielding and testing of the ACAB concept is another major milestone in the continuing effort to derive the maximum combat benefits from the potential offered by the third battlefield dimension which was opened to the Army by the helicopter.

Medical evacuation during the Korean War, the "sky cavalry" concept, the "Howze Board", Vietnam's "proof testing", and the recent third Aviation Requirements for the Combat Structure of the Army (ARCSA III) force implementation are some of the more important and familiar steps in our effort to exploit the potential of the helicopter.

In each step of this continuing effort, we have found ever expanding acceptance and uses of Army Aviation's ability to enhance the classic battlefield missions of reconnaissance, firepower, maneuver, and logistics support. In each step we have also seen an accompanying change in organizational and operational concepts to take greater advantage of the increased combat and combat support effectiveness of the helicopter as provided by improved technology.

The latest effort

The ACAB, therefore, represents the latest effort in this continuing process and is designed to take the maximum advantage of both seasoned or new concepts of employment along with new aviation systems such as the Black Hawk and fully modernized Cobra.

The ACAB will be fielded at Fort Lewis in 1981 with an organizational capability to support flying at two hours per operational aircraft per day. In 1982, additional resources will be provided to build up the ACAB's organizational capability to support flying four hours per operational aircraft per day; a second

A milestone in Army Aviation was reached with the February 27 retirement of Major General James C. Smith . . .

The Director of Training, ODCSOPS, Department of the Army, Smith was the last World War II Army Aviator serving on active duty having been a 1946 graduate of the Liaison Pilot Schools at Sheppard Field, Texas, and Ft. Sill, Oklahoma.

A current National Vice President of the Army Aviation Association, the native of Oglethorpe, GA, completed 39 years of military service. A member of the U.S. Army Aviation Hall of Fame, Smith had two tours in Vietnam, later becoming ADC of the 101st Airborne Division, Commander of the 1st Cavalry Division, and Chief of Staff, UNC/U.S. Forces Korea.

He remained in Korea until coming to Ft. Rucker as Commanding General from June 1976 to December 1978, his last assignment before his HQ position.

The two-star general retired at the February Awards and Retirement Review at Ft. Rucker where he also was the reviewing officer at the ceremony.

Combat Support Aviation Company (CSAC) will be formed, and ACAB testing will begin in earnest.

In 1983 it is planned to provide more resources so that the ACAB will be able to operate and support six flying hours per operational aircraft per day. The two hour rate approximates the present ARCSA III peacetime capability while the six hour rate is what has been determined by TRADOC to be necessary for combat based upon the Army 86 study.

Of the major subordinate units of the ACAB, the CSAB remains essentially the same as the present ARCSA III Combat Aviation Battalion of the light division in both organization and missions, the major difference being the removal of the combat elements (attack helicopters) from the battalion and reconfiguring them into battalion-type organizations.

Emphasis on reconnaissance

The new cavalry squadron is designed to be a light, flexible, and fast moving reconnaissance organization that will provide the "eyes" for the division commander to truly "see the battlefield".

This emphasis on reconnaissance is a reversal of the previous emphasis on cavalry security missions which led to heavier and heavier fighting organizations. This new concept of "light horse" cavalry has become particularly important to find and fix the enemy on the fluid "non-linear" battlefield anticipated in the 1980's.

When the ACAB is fielded in the 9th Infantry Division, it will be provided with fully modernized AH-1S's for the two new attack helicopter battalions (21 each) and the cavalry squadron (eight each).

The brigade also will be provided with UH-60A Black Hawks for the two CSAC's required for the light infantry division. These aircraft represent the most modern systems that are now available to determine if the ACAB organization is the best vehicle to maximize their combat and combat support potential.

The ACAB was designed to accomplish the following:

- Organize aviation units as they will function in combat.
- Separate the various combat, combat support, and service support aviation missions and functions into dedicated battalion/squadron organizations.
- Provide adequate command, control, communications, and supply support to perform aviation missions 24 hours a day under intense combat conditions.
- Standardize aviation TO&E's by providing similar ACAB organizations for both the light and heavy divisions.

ACAB field testing and in-depth analysis will determine the value and evolution of the organization. The final product will be another major milestone in the Army's continuing quest to provide the combat commander with the maximum possible benefit from the helicopter's third battlefield dimension. □

The Army is well along in its plan to support the U.S. effort at the **Fourth World Helicopter Championships** in Poland this August. The FORSCOM Flyoffs are well covered in a five-page report starting on page 33 of this issue, and if the timing is right, we'll cover the **Army Flyoffs** to be held at Ft. Rucker during March 9-13. The Army's eight two-man teams will be cited at our April Convention's Membership Luncheon.

In a very close competition, a 1st Cavalry Division helicopter crew flying an OH-58 finished the U.S. Army Forces Command (FORSCOM) Helicopter Flyoff six points ahead of a Ft. Bragg Special Forces crew, winning the four-day contest with a score of 667.

Two other Ft. Hood crews placed in the top four spaces with teams from Ft. Campbell, Ft. Stewart, and Panama taking the remaining top eight spaces. The eight winning crews will compete with the TRADOC entries in the U.S. Army Flyoffs to be held at Ft. Rucker, March 9-13.

Sanctioned by the National Aeronautic Ass'n (NAA), the flyoffs at Ft. Hood were a preliminary step leading to the eventual selection of a U.S. Helicopter Team to be entered in the World Helicopter Championships (WHC) in Poland, August 14-23.

HCA in supervisory role

With judges from the various posts serving under the supervision of the Helicopter Club of America (HCA), the FORSCOM Helicopter Flyoffs were to have started on Monday, February 9, with a Timed Arrival and Rescue Event but rainy weather and poor visibility

resulted in the cancellation of the first day's flying activities and their rescheduling on the fifth day.

The second day of the competition was bright and sunny with warm temperatures prevailing during most of the day, but the 13 crews going through the day's event had to contend with gusting winds. The Precision Flying Event, described in *Army Aviation*, October 1980, was followed by the Navigation Exercise (see *Army Aviation*, Nov 80) on February 11, the Flyoff's third day and, quite unfortunately, the coldest day of the year.

A two-event day

The last day of the competition turned out calm with a slight overcast — good flying weather for the last two events of the FORSCOM Flyoffs, the Timed Arrival and Rescue Event (postponed from the first day) and the Helicopter Slalom Event shown below.

Going into the slalom event, CW2 Ben VanEtten and CW2 Alan Porter, of Ft. Bragg's

John F. Kennedy Flight Detachment, were in first place, followed closely by CPT Stephen G. Kee and CW2 George D. Chrest, members of D Troop, 1st Squadron, 9th Cavalry, 1st Cavalry Division.

VanEtten and Porter, flying a UH-1H, posted a 188 in the slalom for a total of 661 points, but Kee and Chrest took the lead in the same event by posting a 197, finishing the four days of intense competition with a final — and winning — score of 667 points, just six points ahead of the Ft. Bragg crew.

The crew taking third place consisted of CW3 John T. Bailey and WO1 Jim C. Corbitt, members of B Troop, 7/17, 6th Cav Bde (Air Combat). This crew had finished the November 1980 Ft. Hood-level Flyoff in third place, and had been listed as the post's alternate crew. They were able to take part in the FORSCOM-level competition because some posts scheduled to participate (see box) were unable to compete for one reason or another.

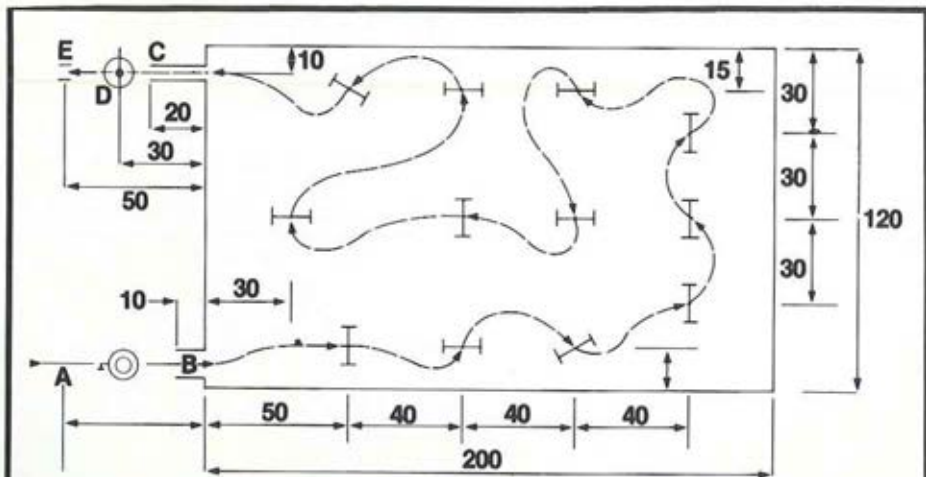

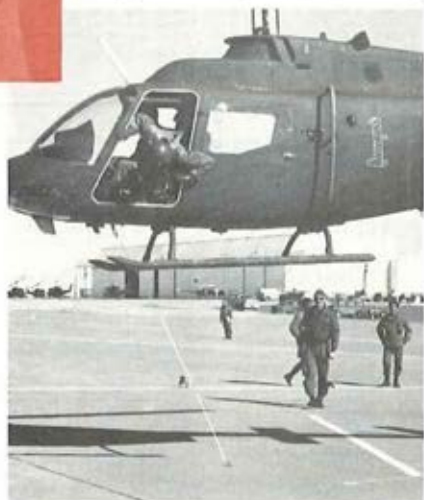

FORTY YEARS OF AVIATION SERVICE

AN extraordinary milestone was reached on February 7 when Chief Warrant Officer (W4) Michael J. Novosel, Sr., completed 40 years of military service. Assigned as Safety Officer in the Directorate of Evaluation/Standardization at USAAVNC, "Mike" Novosel took the unusual milestone in the same way as he's done with all others in his life . . . in stride!

A long career

The only **Medal of Honor** recipient stationed at Ft. Rucker, Novosel entered the Army Air Corps Feb. 7, 1941, and served combat tours in WW II and Vietnam. He also served during the Korean conflict, but wasn't assigned to combat.

A Vice President on AAAA's National Board and Co-Chairman of its Warrant Officer Affairs Committee, Novosel reminisced recently with his son, CW3 Michael J. Novosel, Jr., also an Army Aviator stationed at Ft. Rucker. The latter is an IP in Lowe Division, Dept. of Flight-Training.

The two served a combat tour in Vietnam in

the same unit, the 82nd Medical Detachment, 45th Medical Company, flying medevac missions. It was the second tour in Vietnam for the father, who entered on active duty as an AWO in 1964. At the time, he was a Lieutenant Colonel in the Air Force Reserve and a Southern Airways pilot flying out of New Orleans.

In January 1970, the younger Novosel was assigned to the unit after having completed flight training the month before. By then his father had been overseas for nine months, and had already flown the mission for which he was awarded the **Medal of Honor**.

Flying together

"From the point of view of being a father," said Novosel, speaking of being assigned to combat with his son, "to see your son choose the same profession is gratifying. But it also posed some problems."

The senior Novosel, being one of the most experienced of the unit's 12 aviators, had a hand in making the combat assignments. "I couldn't play favorites," he said. "The hardest times were when he was on a mission and I was back in operations, listening to the radios and hearing him come under fire."

A proud moment in the life of CW4 "Mike" Novosel took place at Ft. Rucker on 23 June 1975 when he and his wife, Ethel, were presented with a souvenir portrait of the same portrait of Mike that now hangs in the Army Aviation Hall of Fame located in the Army Aviation Museum. LTG John M. Wright, Jr., Ret., AAAA National President at the time, made the award presentation at the USAAVNC Induction Banquet.



Due to the small number of aviators in the unit, the pilots often had to go out and rescue their fellow aviators who had been shot down. For the Novosels, it meant one flying out to pick up the other.

On one occasion, the younger Novosel was shot down while flying a mission with another warrant officer. His father flew out to pick them up. On another mission, it was the father's turn to be rescued . . . by his son and another warrant. "It happened so often there that it wasn't anything special," said the senior Novosel.

Different wars

He also reflected on the differences he saw between the two conflicts in which he flew combat missions.

"Flying B-29's (in WW II) was an impersonal situation," he said. "You didn't see where the bombs went. Vietnam was a very personal experience. You could see the enemy shooting at you . . . you could see the blood and gore."

His son added, "Sometimes you'd see the patient smile or give you the thumbs up. Sometimes they didn't make it . . . you never really got used to it."

Being in a small unit also meant making close friendships that often ended in tragedy. "On my first tour in Vietnam in 1964, I was playing bridge with a priest, a doctor, and a

pilot. Six weeks later, I was the only one left," recounted the senior Novosel. "It makes you think about survivability."

Both Novosels are proud of their service flying "Dustoff" missions, the job of evacuating the combat wounded. For the record, the two aviators have 50 years of aviation service, 99 air medals, and, during the three tours, made more than 8,000 evacuations of wounded soldiers. In addition, during the senior Novosel's second tour, he flew 1,410 combat hours, an average of four a day.

Above the best

In 1975, by vote of more than 2,600 AAAA members, CW4 Michael J. Novosel, Sr., was selected for membership in the Army Aviation Hall of Fame at Ft. Rucker's Army Aviation Museum. He was inducted in ceremonies held at Ft. Rucker on June 14 of that year.

Although the two have shared a lot together, the story of the family's military service is not yet complete. John Novosel, the elder Novosel's other son, is a student at Enterprise (Ala.) High School, the community where the family resides.

John is a member of the Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps and hopes to attend the U.S. Naval Academy at Annapolis when he graduates. □

THE ARMY AVIATION SERVICE POLICY

ON 19 October 1980 the Army Staff approved a personnel policy clearly the requirements for an officer or warrant officer to be considered for aviation service on a career basis.

This policy superseded a previous Army practice that allowed commissioned officers not holding an aviation specialty to receive continuous Aviation Career Incentive Pay (ACIP).

Approval of this new Aviation Service Policy insures that the Army is in compliance with Public Law 93-294 (Aviation Career Incentive Act (ACIA) of 1974).

The new Aviation Service Policy is applicable to all rated Army Aviators but the group most directly affected are those officers who were reclassified out of an aviation specialty by a DA Board of officers in 1976 during the initial implementation of OPMS.

Aviators who were precluded by the Board from having aviation as one of their specialties were informed they would receive ACIP as long as they remained eligible under the provision of the 1974 ACIA.

The Defense Audit Service (DAS) questioned the practice of allowing officers not holding an aviation specialty to receive continuous ACIP. The DAS concluded that commissioned officers who do not hold an aviation specialty are not " . . . in aviation on a career basis" and are not entitled to ACIP as prescribed by Public Law.

A proposed Army position was forwarded to the Judge Advocate General and Comptroller for review with a recommendation to continue the current practice.

However, both agencies supported the DAS finding and ruled the practice to be legally objectionable. After months of negotiation and staffing the Army developed the following policy:

Aviation Service Policy

● All active duty Army officers who hold an Army Aviator (or higher) aeronautical rating, or are in training leading toward one, are part of the Army's authorized **rated inventory** and are considered to be engaged in aviation service on a career basis so long as they meet the criteria outlined in the following discussions.

● For management purposes, all aviators receive a **Pilot Status Code (PSC)** of 1 (Aviation Service Qualified) upon award of their aeronautical rating. Aviators will retain a PSC and be managed as aviators to meet peacetime and/or mobilization aviation requirements throughout a career until disqualified. Disqualification results from one of the following:

a. Medical incapacitation per AR 40-501 (PSC 2).

b. **Flight Evaluation Board (FEB)** recommendation and AR 15-6 (PSC 3) - non-medical disqualification.

c. Departure from active duty or a Reserve Component troop unit (PSC 4) - aviator not in aviation service.

d. Voluntary/involuntary withdrawal, upon approval by HQ, Department of the Army (PSC 4).

● The officers below are to be considered in aviation service and are to be counted as the peacetime Army authorized **rated inventory**:

a. Warrant Officer aviators on extended active duty who maintain a **Pilot Status Code 1** and a 100 series military occupational specialty.

b. Commissioned officer aviators on extended active duty who maintain **Pilot Status Code 1** and in **Aviation Specialty Code 1**, and in **Aviation Specialty Code (15, 71, or 67J)**.

c. All commissioned and warrant officer aviators not on extended active duty who:

(1) Are assigned to and performing operational flying duty, or

(2) Are assigned to a rated position in a Reserve Component, or

(3) Are considered by their components as being a part of their **rated inventory** and each of whom within the preceding 24 months were rated officers on active duty or assigned to rated positions.

● Rated officers remain in aviation service until disqualified or terminated.

● The following does not disrupt the career aviation service of a rated officer:

a. Failure to qualify for continuous incentive pay at the 12th or 18th year gate.

b. Assignment to a non-aviation duty position.

● Entitlement to continuous ACIP exists only as long as the officer maintains a **Pilot Status Code 1**, holds an aviation specialty of 15, 67J, or 71, and remains in Army Aviation service on a career basis.

Commissioned aviators not holding OPMS aviation specialties that qualified for ACIP were notified in the November-December 1980 time frame that their **Pilot Status Code** would change from **PSC 1** to **PSC 3**.

The subsequent addition of **PSC 4** (Aviator - not in aviation service) better categorizes their specific situation and, accordingly, their PSC won't be changed from **PSC 1** to **PSC 3**, but will be changed to **PSC 4**.

In summary, the key points of the **Army Aviation Service Policy** are:

● Entitlement to continuous ACIP exists only as long as an officer maintains a **PSC 1** status; holds an aviation specialty of 15, 67J, or 71, or the 100 series MOS; and remains in Army Aviation service on a career basis, and

● The implementation of the **Aviation Service Policy** into the Army Regulations aligns the Army with the intent of the Public Law, and insures that the Army is in full compliance with the intent of the Public Law.

As an Army Aviator, you have not just read "another" policy . . . The foregoing is the policy that establishes the base line for managing your career in Army Aviation.

An understanding of the **Aviation Service Policy** and the Public Law governing ACIP will provide you with all you ever wanted to know about "flight pay" but were afraid to ask. □
